1. **Title: IFRC releases climate e-learning course in four more languages.** Red Cross/Red Crescent Climate Center. (2016).

Description: First launched in March 2014, the climate course was developed for Red Cross Red Crescent staff and volunteers who have limited knowledge of climate change or none. "Through this course, staff and volunteers will learn about the root causes and consequences of climate change and how to help address these issues in their day-to-day work with communities.
